Current Position

- Executive Committee of 12 - meets twice each term
- Meetings open to any governor as observer
- Reports received from officers and SASGB representatives
- All Sheffield schools (i.e. approx. 180 schools) are members of SASGB and the annual subscription forms part of an agreed central retention by the Schools Forum
- Regular meetings with senior CYPF staff and the Cabinet Member for Children's Services (and Shadow CM)
- Recognition as an equal partner on the CWLB supported by Governor Strategy & Policy Partnership Group
